ORDINANCE NO. 722

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH PARK,
ALLEGHENY COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF
PENNSYLVANIA AMENDING CHAPTER 133, ARTICLE III
SECTION 133.23.A OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
SOUTH PARK TO PROHIBIT PARKING AT ALL TIMES ON THE
SOUTH SIDE OF PARKFORD DRIVE AND TO PROHIBIT
PARKING AT ALL TIMES ON THE NORTH SIDE OF PARKFORD
DRIVE FROM THE INTERSECTION OF PARKFORD DRIVE AND
BROWNSVILLE ROAD FROM THE STOP SIGN TO A POINT OF
30 FEET ALONG THE NORTH SIDE OF PARKFORD DRIVE**

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the Township of South Park is empowered under the provisions of the Second Class Township Code to enact ordinances prohibiting vehicle parking upon highways or parts thereof and the erection of official no parking signs on certain public highways, roads and/or streets or parts thereof within the Township of South Park; and

WHEREAS, it appears to the Board of Supervisors of the Township of South Park that a Township Ordinance should be ordained and enacted to establish a no parking area and the erection of official no parking signs on the South side of Parkford Drive and the North side of Parkford Drive from the stop sign at the intersection at Brownsville Road 30 feet along the North side of Parkford Drive within the Township of South Park for the public health, coordinated and practical community development, convenience and general welfare of the residents and/or property owners of the Township of South Park.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of South Park, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by and with the authority of the same as follows:

Section 1. The following shall be added to Chapter 133, Article III, Section 133.23A of the Code of the Township of South Park:

<u>No Parking Signs On</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Location</u>
Parkford Drive	South	entire length of street
Parkford Drive	North	30 feet from stop sign at intersection of Brownsville Road

Section 2. All other provisions of Chapter 133, Article III, Section 133.23A of the Township of South Park Code are hereby restated, re-adopted, reaffirmed and shall remain valid and binding.

Section 3. That any ordinance or parts of any ordinance conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and due publication.
