Judy Woods made a motion to approve the minutes from the previous meeting, Donna Tressler seconded.

LIBRARIAN'S REPORT:

- Grants
 - Baughman Grants
 - Fall Health & Wellness Munch & Learns are open for registration
 - The first session is Wednesday, September 25 @ noon
 - Amanda applied for and received another \$3500 grant
 - Celebrating Our Communities Grant
 - The Smart Board has been great for presentations
 - Couches arrived a couple weeks ago
 - Tables arrived today
 - The last step is to get chairs for the tables
 - ARPA Capital Projects Grant
 - Amanda and Derek applied for a \$750,000 grant to put an addition on the library that will include a presentation space and a Makerspace
 - The library was supposed to be notified in Aug, but there has been a delay
 - State received 600 applications, so the process will be very competitive
- Programming Updates
 - Summer reading was very successful and very busy this year
 - The library offered 184 programs attended by more than 2800 patrons
- Fundraising
 - 2024 Book Sales
 - Fall sale will be Oct. 17-19
 - The library will start accepting donations on Monday, September 30
 - o Teas
 - The Bingo Tea Fundraiser is this Friday, September 13
 - 75 people are registered in addition to a waitlist
 - o Mum sale
 - Drop off date is scheduled for Saturday, September 21

- There were \$920 in sales, which is about \$70 less than last year
- Appeal letters went out at the end of August
 - To date the library has collected more than \$6500
- Holiday Market-Saturday, November 30
 - Applications went out in August
 - 21 vendor spaces are filled
 - Amanda is going to accept 2-3 more vendors
 - The Administration lobby will be used, but the vendors will be spread out more than last vear
- Winter Flower and Wreath Sale
 - We will participate in a winter flower and wreath sale this year with Gumto Greenhouse
 - If it doesn't go well, this will be the last year
- Amanda will be planning a memorial brick campaign ideally for early next year if the expansion grant doesn't go through
