STATE, COUNTY AND TOWNSHIP ROADS

Residents may be unaware that South Park Township is not responsible for the maintenance of every road throughout the community. The Township has been receiving numerous complaints concerning potholes and overgrowth along roadways, as well as road maintenance issues, that are the responsibility of other governmental entities. The following is a list of streets located within the municipality that are under the control/ownership of either the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania (PennDOT) or Allegheny County.
