The Pennsylvania Property Tax/Rent Rebate program is open to *state residents 65 or older, widows and widowers 50 or older, or anyone age 18 and over who is 100% disabled.*

**New income limits for 2024 are \$46,520 a year for BOTH homeowners and renters.**

NOTE: Only half of your Social Security income is included in calculations.

If your income is:	Your maximum rebate is:
\$0 - \$8,270	\$1,000
\$8,271 - \$15,510	\$770
\$15,511 - \$18,610	\$460
\$18,611 - \$46,520	\$380

The following documents are required to complete the process:

- Total Social Security/Railroad Retirement
- Proof of SSI or Disability
- Proof of Age First Time Filer Driver's License or Photo ID
- 1099 Pension Statement(s)
- 1099 Interest Statement(s)
- 1099 Dividend Statement(s)
- Proof of W-2 or Other Income if received
- Voided check showing Routing Number & Account Number if you wish to have payment received by direct deposit

#### - Property Owners -

Proof of Taxes Paid

Either Stamped or Signed by Tax Collector.

#### - Renters -

Rent Certificate Filled Out and Signed by Landlord.
